

# COVID-19 and Camp FGL



During your troops stay at Camp FGL we will be implementing several policies in order to minimize any risk.

This plan is based on the ability to have public gatherings of 100 people.

- 1) Before leaving your meet up location conduct a Pre-Event Health Screening Form for all participants.
- 2) Upon arrival at Camp FGL all Scouts and adult leaders will complete a second Pre-Event Health Screening with our camp medic.
- 3) Daily temperature checks will be conducted at breakfast for all persons on property.
- 4) Handwashing stations will be provided at all program areas.
- 5) Extra sanitation supplies will be provided to each troop for their campsite.
- 6) Strict limits on the number of individuals allowed in the trading post.
- 7) Dining hall seating will be arranged with no more than 5 persons per table. Each table will be 6-8 feet apart.
- 8) Cafeteria style serving for all meals to limit cross contamination.
- 9) Troops may have the option to sleep one person per tent. Troops may also bring a personal tent to use while at camp. If sharing a tent it is recommended to sleep facing in opposite directions.
- 10) No visitors or parents allowed on property unless it is an emergency.
- 11) Adult leaders that must leave the property for any reason must wear the appropriate PPE gear while off property.
- 12) Facemask will not be required, however may be worn at all times or when appropriate.
- 13) At all times maintain the appropriate social distancing guidelines that are recommended by the CDC and local Health Departments.
- 14) Troops will check out on Friday morning in order to give ample time to sanitize camp prior to the arrival of new campers.
